- Supplement No. 2 to FERC 93 (Colonial's Rules and Regulations Tariff) January 1, 2010

Supplement No. 2 to FERC 93 contains the following changes:

1. Item 5A cancels Item 5 and includes various modifications to definitions. Those changes include:
 - The "Cycle Begin Dates" included within the "Nomination Integrity Program" now reflect the dates published in the Origin Starts bulletin provided by Transport 4 for lifting purposes.
 - The definition for "Transport 4" has been added.
 - The "Change Fee Begin Date" has been changed from 10 days to 5 days prior to the "Cycle Begin Date" to align with our current cycle length.
 - A definition for "Closing Date" has been added in order to eliminate any confusion between "Cycle Closing Date" and "Closing Date".
 - The "Point of Origin" definition has been better defined as "origin station or origin".
2. Item 10B cancels Item 10A and updates the link within Colonial's Rules and Regulations Tariff, Supplement No. 2 to FERC 93, for the product specifications located in Colonial's online Shipper Manual. The specific changes to the product specifications can be found in the attached Appendix A: Table of Changes Effective January 1, 2010.

3. Item 29A cancels Item 29. The "Capacity Allocation Program" language is being modified to apply the "Capacity Allocation Program" methodology to all of Colonial's lines. The current "Capacity Allocation Program" fees for lines 1 and 2 remain unchanged. The current "Capacity Allocation Program" fees will not apply to the additional lines.
