FERC 99.7.0 cancels FERC 99.6.0 and contains the following changes:

- With the filing of FERC 99.6.0 effective January 1, 2012, the Table of Contents was not updated with the cancellation and addition of the incentive programs. FERC 99.7.0 corrects the Table of Contents to accurately reflect Colonial's cancellation of Item 284, the Atlanta Hartsfield Airport Volume Incentive Program, as well as the establishment of Item 285, the Charlotte Douglas Airport Volume Incentive Program and Item 286, the Atlanta Hartsfield Airport Volume Incentive Program.
- Item 285 has been updated to clarify that volumes delivered to Charlotte/Charlotte Douglas Airport via both Colonial's local rates tariff, FERC 99.7.0 and via Colonial's joint rates tariff with Bengal Pipeline Company LLC, FERC 100.5.0, cumulatively apply towards the minimum volume threshold of 200,000 barrels.

- Item 286 has been updated to clarify that volumes delivered to Atlanta Hartsfield Airport via both Colonial's local rates tariff, FERC 99.7.0 and via Colonial's joint rates tariff with Bengal Pipeline Company LLC, FERC 100.5.0, cumulatively apply towards the minimum volume threshold of 200,000 barrels.
- Updates to various reference marks.

FERC 100.5.0 cancels FERC 100.4.0 and contains the following changes:

- With the filing of 100.4.0 effective January 1, 2012, the rate from Norco (Saint Charles Parish), LA to Baltimore-Baltimore-Washington International Airport (Anne Arundel County), MD was incorrectly stated. FERC 100.5.0 corrects this rate.
- Item 350 establishes a Charlotte Douglas Airport Volume Incentive Program for deliveries of aviation kerosene to Charlotte/Charlotte Douglas Airport (Mecklenburg County), NC from the origin points of Convent (Saint James Parish), LA and Norco (Saint Charles Parish), LA and is applicable to movements of aviation kerosene to the Charlotte/Charlotte Douglas Airport (Mecklenburg County), NC for volumes in excess of 200,000 barrels in any given program period. In addition, volumes delivered to Charlotte/Charlotte Douglas Airport via both Colonial's local rates tariff, FERC 99.7.0 and via Colonial's joint rates tariff with Bengal Pipeline Company LLC, FERC 100.5.0, cumulatively apply towards the minimum volume threshold of 200,000 barrels. Attached is the "Rates Justification" schedule verifying that the incentive rates are lower than the joint posted rates.
- Item 355 establishes a Atlanta Hartsfield Airport Volume Incentive Program for deliveries of aviation kerosene to Atlanta-Wm. B. Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport (Fulton County), GA from the origin points of Convent (Saint James Parish), LA and Norco (Saint Charles Parish), LA and is applicable to movements of aviation kerosene to the Atlanta-Wm. B. Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport (Fulton County), GA for volumes in excess of 200,000 barrels in any given program period. In addition, volumes delivered to Atlanta Hartsfield Airport via both Colonial's local rates tariff, FERC 99.7.0 and via Colonial's joint rates tariff with Bengal Pipeline Company LLC, FERC 100.5.0, cumulatively apply towards the minimum volume threshold of 200,000 barrels. Attached is the "Rates Justification" schedule verifying that the incentive rates are lower than the local posted rates.
- Updates to various reference marks

Colonial Pipeline Company is requesting a waiver for notice and tariff requirements of section 6(3) of the Interstate Commerce Act in order to file FERC 99.7.0 and FERC 100.5.0 to be effective January 1, 2012 on 22 days notice. FERC 99.7.0 and FERC 100.5.0 are being filed in order to correct and clarify FERC 99.6.0 and FERC 100.5.0 which become effective January 1, 2012.
