Colonial Baton Rouge Bengal Origin Nomination Changes



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What's changing?

- Due to the discontinuation of the Colonial – Bengal Joint Tariff, effective September 1, 2026, there is a change to the Colonial nominations process for Bengal origins.
- The change only impacts the Colonial nominations system (no Bengal nominations system impacts).
- In the Colonial nominations system on Transport4, inbound nominations to Colonial from Bengal will require a “Transfer Receipt” event type, instead of a Receipt (RCP) event type. The nomination is required to be linked to the correct Bengal supplier nomination. Please see the example on the next page.
- The change is effective with Colonial Cycle 50. All existing nominations starting with C50 must be updated.
- The system will support the changes to the existing nominations effective August 26th.
- There are no changes to nominations for volumes lifting out of other Colonial Baton Rouge origins, such as ELS, CPC Baton Rouge Dock or Marathon Zachary.

- In T4, shipper creates a new batch, using “Transfer Receipt” as the origin event type
- “Sup/Con” and “Link Shipper” will always be the same code. “Tankage” is always “BEN”
- “Link Product” is the same as the product type in the batch code. “Link Cycle” is always “00”.
- Designate “Link Sequence” based on the Bengal origin linked code as provided by the supplier: B, N or G.
- **All existing nominations starting with cycle 50 must be updated.**
